ACATIS Fair Value Investment AG has invited Prof. Dr. Falko Paetzold to the Sustainability Advisory Board for the ACATIS Fair Value funds under its management.

Prof. Dr. Falko Paetzold joins Prof. Dr. Henry Schäfer and Dr. Wouter Pronk. He is an insider and expert in the area of impact investing.

We want to be prepared and ready for the sustainability challenges for the future. Which types of additions make sense for our already unique ACATIS Fair Value sustainability strategy? Which new strategies should or could we implement? What will the sustainability models of the future look like? CO2 footprint or climate analysis - how can we implement them? All of these questions are constantly on our minds. That is why we have established the ACATIS Fair Value Sustainability Advisory Board, a competent and independent body that acts on behalf of investors and assists us with many questions as a discussion partner and advisor.

Prof. Paetzold is Assistant Professor in Social Finance at EBS Universität, and the founder and Director of the Center for Sustainable Finance and Private Wealth (CSP) at the University of Zurich.

The CSP is a spin-off from the Impact Investing for the Next Generation Program for very wealthy individuals, which he co-initiated in 2015 as a Fellow of the Initiative for Responsible Investment (IRI) at Harvard University. His research investigates the decision-making processes of very wealthy families in the context of Social Finance, and how investors can

maximise their positive influence. He obtained his doctorate at the University of Zurich (magna cum laude) and completed his MBA at the University of St. Gallen (HSG) (Dean's List, Sustainability Leadership). Falko Paetzold was a research associate and lecturer at ETH Zurich, a fellow at Harvard University and a post-doc at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). His publications include academic works in magazines such as Organization & Environment, experience reports with the World Economic Forum and the Swiss environment ministry, as well as a Harvard Business School Teaching Case with Prof. Julie Battilana.

In the past, Prof. Paetzold worked as a sustainability analyst and in internal consulting (M&A) at Bank Vontobel AG in Zurich, and he also advised banks and family offices as a partner of the consulting company Contrast Capital. He founded the network GreenBuzz, which enables companies in several cities to promote sustainability in their own firms.

We look forward to working with Prof. Dr. Falko Paetzold, and his input.
